ORDINANCE NO. 4675

AN ORDINANCE relating to levying the property taxes of King County for the year 1980, and amending Ordinance No. 4611, Section 2, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4611, Section 2, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

The Council of King County, Washington, finds that the levies necessary to fund estimated expenditures for the year 1980, less the total of estimated revenues from sources other than taxation, including available surplus, and exclusive of any supplemental collections of prior years' taxes due as a result of the Burlington Northern Case, and such expenditures as are to be met from bond warrant issues, be and the same are hereby fixed as follows:
