

ORDINANCE NO. **4713**

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$5,654,855 from the Public Health Pooling Fund and amending Ordinance 4597, Section 47.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 4597, Section 47, Public Health Pooling, is hereby amended as follows:

~~((THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL IS CONCERNED THAT:~~

- ~~1)--The reorganization proposed in the Health Department budget makes no real progress in effecting transfer of administration to King County and sets back the compromise package which was being developed jointly by County and City Council committees.~~
- ~~2)--The proposed restructuring terminates the regional approach to health service delivery and establishes a dual delivery system based on political boundaries.~~
- ~~3)--Implementation of the dual delivery system will lead to duplication and inefficiencies, especially with regard to environmental services.~~

The Council intends that:

- o The joint work toward an agreement regarding transfer, structure and funding be expedited.
- o The Department's structure and funding formula continue as in 1979 until an agreement is reached.
- o The agreement address:
 - a. Transfer of administration to ensure direct accountability to the 60% of the County population outside Seattle;
 - b. Joint appointment of the Director;
 - c. The concerns expressed by the City regarding funding responsibilities.

THEREFORE:))

From the Public Health Pooling Fund there is hereby appropriated: ~~(((\$1,798,392))~~ \$7,453,247. ~~((as an amount equal to three months operating costs to be expended consistent with the 1979 structure and funding formula.))~~

PROVIDED THAT:

- 1) No funds shall be expended for the costs of ~~((restructuring or))~~ the three primary care pilot projects.

((2) No funds shall be expended to transfer programs to the new Seattle computer pending a decision on transfer of administration to the County.))

The King County Council ((~~further~~)) intends that:

((~~e---The-funds-for-the-remainder-of-1980-in-the-amount-of \$5,395,175-be-appropriated-consistent-with-an-agreement satisfactory-to-the-City-of-Seattle-and-to-King-County-~~))

o The amount of ((~~\$240,123~~)) \$37,162 be held in the Pooling Fund and may be applied to any increased County cost related to transfer of administration or minor differences in the appropriation between City and County.
