

ORDINANCE NO. 4745

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Annexation #4 to Bryn Mawr-Lakeridge Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Annexation #4 to Bryn Mawr-Lakeridge Sewer District was filed with the County Council effective December 24, 1979.

2. Bryn Mawr-Lakeridge Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 207, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Bryn Mawr-Lakeridge Sewer District filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated March 2, 1977, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 25th day of February, 1980, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Bryn Mawr-Lakeridge Sewer District of the area known as Annexation #4 and described in Section 3 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.

SECTION 3. The area known as Annexation #4 to be annexed is described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the east margin of 82nd Avenue South with the east-west centerline of the SE1/4 of the SE1/4 of the SE1/4 of Section 12, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M.;

Thence north along the said east margin of 82nd Avenue South to an intersection with the south margin of South 126th Street which is the present south boundary of the Bryn Mawr-Lakeridge Sewer District;

Thence easterly along said south street margin to the west right of way margin of 84th Avenue South;

Thence south along said west right of way margin to an intersection with the east-west centerline of the SE1/4 of the SE1/4 of the SE1/4 of said Section 12;

Thence westerly along said subdivision line to the POINT OF BEGINNING.
