ORDINANCE NO. 4756

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$63,704 from unanticipated Federal and State reimbursables to the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney to support costs associated with the relocation of the Domestic Relations Section, the reclassification of support staff assigned to the Domestic Relations Section, and certain costs associated with the operation and maintenance of the Domestic Relations Section of the Prosecutor's Office, amending Ordinance No. 4597, Section 35.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation of \$63,704 from unanticipated Current Expense revenue to the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney to support costs associated with the relocation of the Domestic Relations Section, reclassification of support staff assigned to the Domestic Relations Section, and certain costs associated with the operation and maintenance of the Domestic Relations Section of the Prosecutor's Office is hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 4597, Section 35, is hereby amended to read as follows:
