

ORDINANCE NO. 4761

AN ORDINANCE relating to no shooting areas; establishing a no shooting area within portions of Jovita and Spider Lake voting precincts; adding a new section to KCC 12.68.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. There is added to KCC 12.68 a new section to read as follows:

Jovita Heights - Spider Lake. The shooting of firearms is prohibited and a no shooting area is established comprising the following legally described area:

All that portion of Section 26 and Section 27, Township 21 N., Range 4 E., W.M. lying Westerly of the corporate city limits of Algona and Pacific; EXCEPT that portion previously designated "No Shooting" by King County Resolution No. 9791.

PROVIDED, that property owners or their designated representative may discharge weapons using blank round ammunition as part of the process of training hunting dogs.

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 5th day of February, 1979.

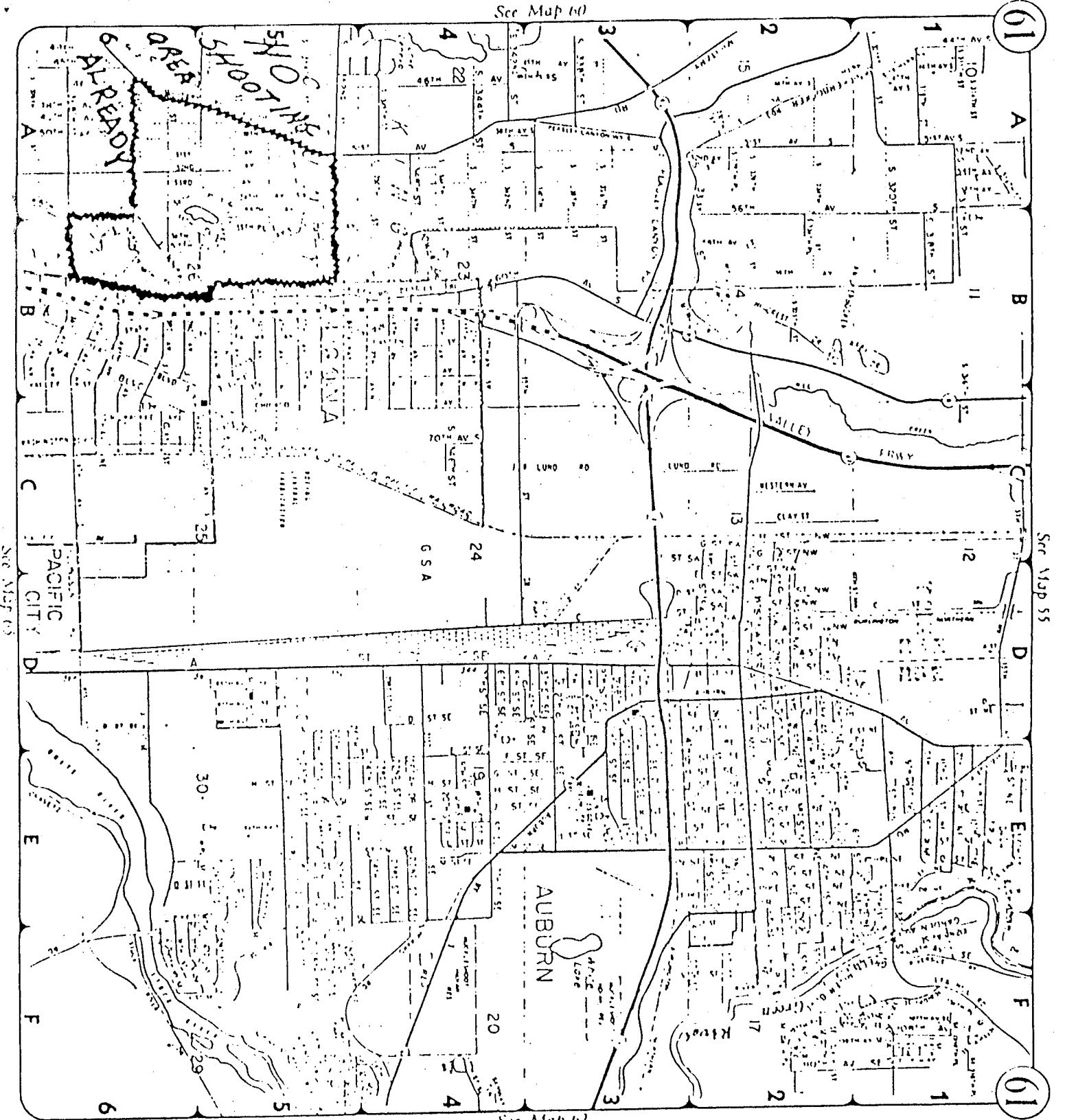
