

ORDINANCE NO. 4785

AN ORDINANCE requiring business proprietors to exclude minors from any room or place where devices, contrivances, instruments, or paraphernalia for the smoking, ingestion, injection, or consumption of marijuana, hashish, PCP, or any controlled substance is displayed or offered for sale, and regulating the gift, sale, or delivery of such devices to minors.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. a. Minors. With respect to any owners, manager, proprietor, or other person in charge of any room or enclosure in any place of business selling, or displaying for the purpose of sale, any device, contrivance, instrument or paraphernalia for the smoking, ingestion, injection, or consumption of marijuana, hashish, PCP, or any controlled substance, as defined in chapter 69.50 RCW (Uniform Controlled Substances Act), other than prescription drugs and devices to ingest or inject prescription drugs, as well as roach clips, and cigarette papers and rollers designed or commonly used for the smoking of the foregoing, no such person, under circumstances evincing his or her intent that any such item or items so sold or displayed be used or employed by another in the commission of a criminal violation of chapter 69.50 RCW, shall allow or permit any person under the age of eighteen years to be, remain in, enter, or visit such room or enclosure unless such minor person is accompanied by one of his or her parents, or by his or her legal guardian.

b. Minors - Excluded. No person under the age of eighteen years shall be, remain in, enter or visit any room or enclosure in any place used for the sale, or displaying for sale, of any device, contrivance, instrument or paraphernalia for the smoking, ingestion, injection, or consumption of marijuana, hashish, PCP, or any controlled substance, as defined in chapter 69.50 RCW (Uniform Controlled Substances Act), other than prescription drugs and devices to ingest or inject prescription drugs, as well as

2 used for smoking the foregoing, under circumstances evincing the
3 intent of the person in charge of such room or enclosure that any
4 such item or items so sold or displayed be used or employed by
5 another in the commission of a criminal violation of chapter 69.50
6 RCW, unless such person under the age of eighteen years is accom-
7 panied by one of his or her parents, or by his or her legal
8 guardian.

9 c. Sale and Display Rooms. No person shall maintain in
10 any place of business to which the public is invited the display
11 for sale, or the offering to sell, of any device, contrivance,
12 instrument or paraphernalia for the smoking, ingestion, injec-
13 tion, or consumption of marijuana, hashish, PCP, or any controlled
14 substance, as defined in chapter 69.50 RCW (Uniform Controlled
15 Substances Act), other than prescription drugs and devices to in-
16 gest or inject prescription drugs, as well as roach clips, and
17 cigarette papers and rollers designed or commonly used for smoking
18 the foregoing, under circumstances evincing his or her intent that
19 any such item or items so sold or displayed be used or employed by
20 another in the commission of a criminal violation of chapter 69.50
21 RCW, unless within a separate room or enclosure to which minors not
22 accompanied by a parent or legal guardian are excluded. At each
23 entrance to such a room or enclosure shall be a sign posted in
24 reasonably visible and legible words to the effect that minors
25 unless accompanied by a parent or legal guardian are excluded.

26 SECTION 2. Violation a misdemeanor. Any violation of
27 this ordinance is a misdemeanor, and the punishment shall be as
28 provided by the laws of the State of Washington.
