ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE approving the Water System Comprehensive Plan for Sallal Water Association.

PREAMBLE:

The Sallal Water System Comprehensive Plan was accepted by the Sallal Board of Directors on January 16, 1980.

King County filed a Declaration of Non-Significance for the approval of the Sallal Water Plan on March 3, 1980.

As required by KCC 13.24, the Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed Sallal Water System Comprehensive Plan and on February 13, 1980 recommended its approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Sallal Water Association Water System Comprehensive Plan - December 1979 (attached) is hereby approved provided no service shall be initiated to areas which may impact the Mount Si Conservation Area without review by the County Council.
