AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to approve subject to conditions, (modified) the application for Unclassified Use Permit petitioned by PALMER COKING COAL and designated File No. 108-80-U, and declaring and emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of King County:


SECTION 1. This Ordinance does hereby adopt and incorporate herein the findings and conclusions contained in the report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner dated March 6, 1980, which was filed with the Clerk of the Council on March 21, 1980, to approve subject to conditions (modified) the application for Unclassified Use Permit petitioned by PALMER COKING COAL designated by the Building and Land Development Division, Department of Planning and Community Development, File No. 108-80-U, and the Council does hereby adopt as its action the recommendation(s) contained in said report.

SECTION 2. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.


