ORDINANCE NO. 4805

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as 28th Avenue South to Lakehaven Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as "28th Avenue South" to Lakehaven Sewer District was filed with the County Council February 19, 1980.

2. Lakehaven Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 79-745, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Lakehaven Sewer District filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated January 10, 1980, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 31st day of march, 1980, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Lakehaven Sewer District of the area known as "28th Avenue South" and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as "28th Avenue South" to be annexed is described as follows:

That portion of the East half of the Southeast quarter of Section 9, Township 21 North, Range 4 East W.M., King County Washington, lying Westerly of the Westerly (limited access) right-of-way margin of Interstate Highway 5.

AND ALSO,

The Southerly 208.5 feet of that portion of the East half of the Northeast quarter of said Section 9 lying Westerly of the Westerly right-of-way margin of Interstate Highway 5; EXCEPT the Westerly 180 feet thereof.
