ORDINANCE NO. 4806

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as "51st Avenue South/South 296th Street" to Lakehaven Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as "51st Avenue South/South 296th Street" to Lakehaven Sewer District was filed with the County Council February 19, 1980.

2.. Lakehaven Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 80-746 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Lakehaven Sewer District filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated January 31, 1980, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 31st day of March, 1980, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Lakehaven Sewer District of the area known as "51st Avenue South/South 296th Street" and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

3 The West 175.96 feet of the South half of
4 the Southwest quarter of the Southwest
5 quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section
6 2, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M. in
7 King County, Washington.
