

ORDINANCE NO. 4847

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Stillwater Road to King County Water District No. 119.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Stillwater Road to King County Water District No. 119 was filed with the County Council effective February 19, 1980.

2. King County Water District No. 119 has found the two petitions for two parcels which are contiguous, and which were consolidated into one annexation proceeding, to be sufficient and has by Resolution 97, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 119 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated January 17, 1980 on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 21st day of April, 1980, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

5. A triangular shaped portion of the proposed annexation as shown in Attachment A has the following characteristics under applicable King County ordinances: zoned Agricultural, designated Agricultural Lands of County Significance, located within the 100 year flood plain and identified as wetlands.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 119 known as Stillwater, and described in Section 2 herein is hereby approved as amended.

SECTION 2. The area known as Stillwater, to be annexed, is described as follows:

The Northeast quarter of Section 4, Township 25 North, Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian; and the East half of the Northwest quarter of said Section 4; and the East 150 feet of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of said Section 4; and that portion of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 4 lying northerly of the South right-of-way line of the Carnation-Duvall Road, N.E.; and that portion of Government Lot 4, lying

1 northerly of the South right-of-way line of the  
2 Carnation-Duvall Road NE, except that portion  
3 lying southerly of a line following the south  
4 right-of-way line of the Carnation-Duvall Road NE  
and a line following the south boundary of the plat  
of Stillwater.
