ORDINANCE NO. 4848

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as "SW 304th St/21st Ave. SW" to Lakehaven Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as "SW 304th St/21st Ave. SW" to Lakehaven Sewer District was filed with the County Council March 8, 1980.

2. Lakehaven Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 80-747, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Lakehaven Sewer District filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant impact dated February 6, 1980, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 21st day of April 1980, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Lakehaven Sewer District of the area known as "SW 304th St/21st Ave. SW" and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as "SW 304th St/21st Ave. SW" to be annexed is described as follows:

Those portions of Section 12, Township 21 North, Range 3 East, W.M. in King County, Washington described as follows:

The North half of the South half of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of said Section 12;

TOGETHER WITH the West half of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of said Section 12.

SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.
