ORDINANCE NO. 4876

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$54,318 to the Alcoholism Fund to maintain current level services for private nonprofit alcoholism agencies amending Ordinance No. 4597, Section 47, as amended and Section 49.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An amount of \$54,318 is hereby appropriated to the Alcoholism Fund from unappropriated Public Health Pooling funds to provide for maintaining services for clients formerly served by the Downtown Community Alcoholism Center.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 4597, Section 49, is hereby amended as follows:

From the Alcoholism Fund there is hereby appropriated:

(((\$4,754,162)) \$4,808,480

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 4597, Section 47, as amended is hereby amended as follows:

The Council intends that:

- . The joint work toward an agreement regarding transfer, structure and funding be expedited.
- . The Department's structure and funding formula continue as in 1979 until an agreement is reached.
- . The agreement address:
  - a. Transfer of administration to ensure direct accountability to the 60% of the County population outside Seattle;
  - b. Joint appointment of the Director;
  - c. The concerns expressed by the City regarding funding responsibilities.

THEREFORE:

From the Public Health Pooling Fund there is hereby appropriated: ((\$7,453,247)) \$7,507,565.

PROVIDED THAT:

- 1) No funds shall be expended for the cost of the three primary care pilot projects.
- 2) No funds shall be expended to transfer programs to the new Seattle computer pending a decision on transfer of administration to the County.



appropriation between City and County.




