ORDINANCE NO. 4880

AN ORDINANCE approving Amendment No. 1 to the City of Bellevue Water Distribution Study.

PREAMBLE:

The City of Bellevue has approved Amendment No. 1 to their Water Distribution Study through the provisions of City Ordinance No. 2665 and City Resolution No. 3452.

The City of Bellevue filed a Declaration of Non-Significance for the proposed amendment on March 7, 1980.

As required by KCC Chapter 13.24, the Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed Amendment No. 1 and on April 9, 1980 recommended its approval with the following findings:

1) The proposed Sammamish Reservoir was previously shown on the former Water District 97 Comprehensive Plan. The City of Bellevue has jurisdiction over the former Water District 97.

2) The proposed Sammamish Reservoir was omitted from the recently approved City of Bellevue Water Distribution Study because of a drafting error in the preparation of the study.

3) The Sammamish Reservoir is necessary to provide adequate service to existing and permitted uses in the Greenwood Point Area of King County.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:




