

ORDINANCE NO. 4997

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$541,550 to the Human Services Division from State Department of Social and Health Services in order to direct funds from the National Institute on Drug Abuse to community-based drug abuse agencies in King County, amending Ordinance No. 4597, Section 48, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$541,550 to the Human Services Division from State Department of Social and Health Services in order to direct funds from the National Institute on Drug Abuse to community-based drug abuse agencies in King County.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 4597, Section 48, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
