ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the King County Division of the Medical Examiner granting the power to subpoena medical records for the investigation of deaths, adding a new section to King County Code § 2.24 and Ordinance 2878.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. Power Granted. The King County Division of the Medical Examiner is hereby granted the power and authority to issue subpoenas to compel the production of medical and dental records, and such other documents as are necessary for the full investigation of any case under the jurisdiction of the Division of the Medical Examiner, from any person, organization or other entity in possession of such records or documents. The power to subpoena medical and dental records shall be vested in the Chief Medical Examiner or his successor, and shall not be limited to cases in which an inquest will be held.

## NEW SECTION. SECTION 2. Enforcement.

- A. Subpoenas issued by the Division of the Medical Examiner shall be enforceable through the Superior Court for King County.
- B. In case of refusal to obey a subpoena, the Chief Medical Examiner may invoke the aid of the King County Prosecuting Attorney who shall apply to the court for an order or other appropriate action necessary to secure enforcement of the subpoena.
- C. Punishment for contempt for failure to comply with a subpoena issued by the Division of the Medical Examiner pursuant to the investigatory functions of said office shall be limited to a fine not exceeding twenty-five dollars or imprisonment in county jail not exceeding two days.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 3. Severability. Should any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, · 3 that determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance.
