ORDINANCE NO. 5082

AN ORDINANCE approving the Water General Comprehensive Plan for King County Water District No. 125 as adopted by Resolution No. 80 05 14 - 58.

PREAMBLE:

In March 1975, Ordinance No. 2321 granted approval to the merger of Water District No. 35 with Water District No. 38.

In October 1976, Motion No. 2724 accepted the Comprehensive Plan for Water District No. 38.

In August 1977, Ordinance No. 3327 granted approval for the consolidation of Water District No. 43 and Water District No. 38. The consolidated districts were designated as Water District No. 125.

On May 14, 1980, Water District No. 125 passed Resolution No. 80 05 14 - 58, adopting a comprehensive plan for the district and submitted it to King County for approval as required by RCW 57.16.010 and Chapter 13.24 KCC.

In July 1980, the Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed plan and on July 16, 1980, recommended its approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Water District No. 125 Water Comprehensive Plan as adopted by district Resolution No. 80 05 14 - 58 (attached) is hereby approved.
