ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Ganchorre to King County Water District No. 111.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Ganchorre to Water District No. 111 was filed with the County Council September 2, 1980.

2. King County Water District No. 111 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 150-5-80 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 111 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated June 12, 1980, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 29th day of September, 19 80, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 111 of the area known as Ganchorre and described in Section 3 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.
