

ORDINANCE NO. 5125

AN ORDINANCE relating to traffic control, prohibiting loads in excess of 34,000 pounds except for local deliveries in King County on South and Southwest 356th and amending K.C.C. 46.44.080-2, Schedule 21.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. K.C.C. 46.44.080-2, Schedule 21, prohibiting operation of trucks and other vehicles on County roads as authorized in the King County Traffic Code, is hereby amended by adding the following:

South and Southwest 356th 34,000 pounds
(except local deliveries to King County)

from Pacific Highway So., westerly to the Pierce County line.

SECTION 2. Signs to evidence the above described restriction shall be installed by the proper authority and shall read, "Load Limit 34,000 pounds except local deliveries in King County."
