ORDINANCE NO. 5199

AN ORDINANCE adopting the Sewerage General Plan for Langston County Sewer Service Area under the provisions of RCW 36.94 and KCC 20.12.030.

PREAMBLE:

The Council of King County declares it advisable and necessary to establish, purchase, acquire and construct a system of sewerage for an area of the County for the health and general welfare of the inhabitants of the County.

A comprehensive sewerage plan, entitled "Sewerage General Plan Langston Utility Local Improvement Districts 3 and 4" has been prepared. The Langston Sewer Area Subcommittee of the King County Sewerage General Plan Review Committee, selected and organized, reviewed the plan and, on August 14, 1980, recommended that it be approved.

On September 17, 1980, King County filed a Final Declaration of Non-Significance for the approval of the Langston Utility Local Improvement Districts 3 and 4. The Metro Council by Resolution _____ has approved the plan pursuant to RCW 36.94. Sewer service to this area is consistent with the King County Sewerage General Plan.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The "Sewerage General Plan Langston Utility Local Improvement Districts 3 and 4" (attached) is hereby approved.

Under the provisions of RCW 36.94 and KCC 20.12.030, the Sewerage General Plan Langston Utility Local Improvement Districts 3 and 4 amends, amplifies, and augments the Comprehensive Plan for King County and the King County Sewerage General Plan, Chapter 7.
