ORDINANCE NO. 5217

AN ORDINANCE concurring with the Recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying certain property upon the application of RAINIER FUND, INC., designated Building and Land Development File No. 269-80-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance does hereby adopt and incorporate herein the findings and conclusions contained in the report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner dated October 29, 1980, filed with the Clerk of the Council on November 13, 1980, recommending action upon the application of RAINIER FUND, INC. to reclassify certain real property described in Building and Land Development File No. 269-80-R.

SECTION 2. The recommendation by the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to reclassify the subject property BC (PUD) to BC-P is hereby adopted by the Council of King County. Those conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied on or before December 31, 1981, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. (If none, the effective date shall be ten days after enactment.) Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the Building and Land Development Division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
