ORDINANCE NO. 5309

AN ORDINANCE approving the Comprehensive Water System Plan for the Town of Duvall.

PREAMBLE:

On April 28, 1977, the Town of Duvall passed Ordinance No. 227 and adopted its comprehensive water system plan, dated April 1977.

On April 28, 1977, the Town of Duvall filed a Final Declaration of Non-Significance for the approval of the Comprehensive Water System Plan.

On October 6, 1980, the proposed Comprehensive Water System Plan was submitted for review by the Utilities Technical Review Committee, as required by KCC 13.24. On October 22, 1980, the Committee recommended that it be approved by the Council.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:


SECTION 1. The Town of Duvall Comprehensive Water System Plan, dated April 1977 (attached), is hereby approved.


