ORDINANCE NO. 5371

AN ORDINANCE approving the "156th Avenue N.E."  
Sewer Comprehensive Plan for the City of Redmond.

PREAMBLE:

On January 20, 1981, the City of Redmond approved the "156th Avenue N.E." Comprehensive Sewer Plan.

On December 18, 1980, the City of Redmond filed a Final Declaration of Non-Significance for the approval of the Comprehensive Sewer Plan.

On November 21, 1980, the proposed Comprehensive Sewer Plan was submitted for review by the Utilities Technical Review Committee as required by KCC 13.24. On December 10, 1980, the Committee recommended that it be approved after making the following findings:

1. The City of Redmond does not have an approved sewer comprehensive plan but has relied instead upon the use of a comprehensive drainage basin analysis and study, and a strict policy of limiting service to within its corporate limits.

2. Construction of SR 520 and natural topography have created a drainage basin in which sewer service can be extended to a portion of the City of Redmond only by trans-versing a portion of unincorporated King County.

3. King County property owners within the drainage basin have petitioned the City of Redmond for sewer service.

4. The existing 156th Avenue N.E. trunk sewer has the capacity to serve the additional area and is totally independent of other portions of the Redmond sewer system as it connects directly to the Metro Interceptor.



SECTION 1. The City of Redmond "156th Avenue N.E." Sewer Comprehensive Plan, dated November 1980 (attached) is hereby approved.


