4 ORDINANCE NO. 5454

5 AN ORDINANCE relating to the Forward Thrust Arterial
6 Resolution No. 34569; finding certain projects for the
7 Cities of Auburn and Pacific to be completed; duly
8 providing for the completion of certain projections; and
9 adding additional projects.

10 PREAMBLE:

11 King County Resolution No. 34569 (hereinafter "Resolution")
12 was adopted by the Board of County Commissioners (now the
13 King County Council under the King County Executive) on
14 December 18, 1967 and is commonly referred to as the Forward
15 Thrust Arterial Highway Improvement Bond Resolution.

16 This Resolution was approved by the voters of King County on
17 the 13th day of February 1968. The voters authorized the
18 issuance of General Obligation Bonds for the purpose of
19 improving existing public arterial highway facilities or
20 constructing new public arterial highway facilities all
21 within King County by the various cities and towns in King
22 County.

23 Arterial highway facilities as contemplated by the Resolution
24 and defined therein mean public roads lawfully designated as
25 arterials by the State of Washington and other appropriate
26 governmental agencies. Projects described in Section 3 of
27 the Resolution assigned to the cities of Auburn and Pacific
28 provide that no projects are limited solely to the facilities
29 listed and the funds are available for additional arterial
30 highway facilities.

31 Paragraph FF of Section 3 of the Resolution provides for
32 improvement of traffic control signals and street lighting
33 served by underground wiring to be done with the incorporated
limits of cities other than the City of Seattle.

Section 6 of the Resolution provides in part that if all
projects which the local governmental agency has been
authorized to accomplish have been completed or completion
duly provided for, such excess bond proceeds may be applied
to carry out such other public arterial highway facilities
purposes within the territory limits of the agency as may be
determined by the legislative authority thereof and found by
the Board of County Commissioners to be consistent with the
purposes of the Resolution and to be a County purpose.

No. 1145 adding a new arterial highway facility to the
previously designated projects contained in the Resolution
to-wit:

1. 22nd N.E. from Auburn Way North to "M" St. N.E.

The city of Auburn by letter of 6 November 1980 from the Director of Public Works for the city of Auburn to the King County Department of Community Development has represented that all other projects originally designated in the Resolution or amended and added to the Resolution or deleted from the Resolution have been completed or otherwise duly provided for.

The City of Pacific on 22 October 1980 enacted Resolution No. 266 which Resolution finds that the street projects listed in the Resolution have been completed and further finds that surplus funds exist in its account and therefore has determined that bond proceeds be applied to carry out the following arterial highway facilities purposes within the territorial limits of the city of Pacific to-wit:

1. Ellison Road from East Valley Highway to West Valley Highway.
2. Milwaukee Boulevard from 5th Ave. North to 5th Ave. South.
3. Seattle Boulevard from 3rd Ave. S.W. to 5th Ave. S.W.
4. Tacoma Boulevard from 5th Ave. South to 5th Ave. North
5. 2nd Ave. S.E. and S.W. from Seattle Boulevard South to Cedar Lane.
6. East Valley Highway from the North City limits to the South city limits.
7. West Valley Highway from the North City limits to the South City limits.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. CONCLUSIONS. The King County

Council finds that the projects described in the City of Auburn Ordinance No. 1145 and City of Pacific Resolution No. 266 are determined to be consistent with the purposes of Resolution 34569 and are County purposes.

Resolution No. 1145 of the City of Auburn and Resolution No. 266 of the City of Pacific and the letter and attachments from the City of Auburn Director of Public Works dated 6 November 1980 are attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance.

Based upon these conclusions the Council hereby determines additional surplus bond proceeds are available to the Cities of Auburn and Pacific and further the Council determines that

1 additional projects can be accomplished which are consistent with
 2 Resolution 34569 for a County purpose and therefore it is hereby
 3 specified, ratified and approved to expend such bond proceeds
 4 upon the following new designated projects.

5 Auburn:

- 6 1. 22nd N.E. from Auburn Way North to "M" St. N.E.

7 Pacific:

- 8 1. Ellison Road from East Valley Highway to
 9 West Valley Highway.
 10 2. Milwaukee Boulevard from 5th Ave. North
 11 to 5th Ave. South.
 12 3. Seattle Boulevard from 3rd Ave S.W. to
 13 5th Ave. S.W.
 14 4. Tacoma Boulevard from 5th Ave. South to
 15 5th Ave. North.
 16 5. 2nd Ave. S.E. and S.W. from Seattle Boulevard
 17 South to Cedar Lane.
 18 6. East Valley Highway from the North City limits
 19 to the South city limits.
 20 7. West Valley Highway from the North City limits
 21 to the South city limits.

22 Subject to the provisions of this Resolution, the Plan for
 23 the acquisition, construction, development and improvement of
 24 Public Arterial Highway Facilities generally described in this
 25 section is hereby adopted and shall be carried out by the
 26 designated Governmental Agency set forth for each Project. No
 27 Project shall be limited solely to the facilities or work listed
 28 in such general description and if funds are available for
 29 additional Arterial Highway Facilities they may be used therefor.
