

ORDINANCE NO. 5497

AN ORDINANCE modifying the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner and granting the appeal of Al and Donna DeYoung, et al, from the Declaration of Non-Significance for the Woodinville Center Development Guide, File No. 1-81.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

This Ordinance does hereby adopt and incorporate herein the findings and conclusions contained in the report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner dated March 25, 1981 which was filed with the Clerk of the Council on April 21, 1981. The appeal by Al and Donna DeYoung and Canterbury Square Mobile Home Park of the declaration of environmental non-significance for the Woodinville Center Development Guide, which declaration was made by the Division of Planning of the King County Department of Planning and Community Development, is hereby sustained.

The Council directs that any reference to a proposed "South Ring Road" (identified as "Project 2" in exhibit 2 in this proceeding) shall be deleted from the current draft Woodinville Center Development Guide. With that deletion made, the threshold determination of environmental non-significance, made by the Manager of the King County Division of Planning for the proposed adoption of the Woodinville Center Development Guide by the King County Council, is hereby confirmed.


Prior to any future presentation to the King County Council of a proposed "South Ring Road" to by-pass the Woodinville business section, the Manager of the Division of Planning, or other appropriate county official, shall prepare an environmental checklist, and there shall be issued a declaration of

1 environmental significance or non-significance (threshold determination) which
2 considers the reasonably probable impacts which may result from construction
3 of the proposed South Ring Road at the location proposed.
