AN ORDINANCE repealing Ordinance No. 4816, and concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to approve RM-2400-P subject to conditions, upon the application for reclassification from RS 7200 (Potential RM 2400) to RM 2400, petitioned by ROBERT A. GROHMAN, and designated File No. 211-80-R.
