ORDINANCE NO. 5542

AN ORDINANCE concurring with the Recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying certain property upon the application of KENNETH H. & MARY EASTLACK. designated Building and Land Development File No. 203-80-S.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance does hereby adopt and incorporate herein the findings and conclusions contained in the report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner dated May 27, 1981, filed with the Clerk of the Council on June 18, 1981, recommending action upon the application of KENNETH H. & MARY EASTLACK, to reclassify certain real property described in Building and Land Development File No. 203-80-S.

SECTION 2. The recommendation by the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to reclassify the subject property to Timberland, is hereby adopted by the Council of King County. Those conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within six months of the date of Council action or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force of effect. (If none, the effective date shall be ten days after enactment.) Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the Building and Land Development Division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
