ORDINANCE NO. 5549

AN ORDINANCE approving the "ULID 81-A and Parkside Interceptor" Additions and Betterments to the Des Moines Sewer District Comprehensive Plan (Resolution No. 1981-11).

On April 8, 1981, Des Moines Sewer District adopted Resolution No. 1981-11, which provided for the "ULID 81-A and Parkside Interceptor" additions and Betterments to the district's comprehensive plan.

This additions and betterments is exempt from the requirements of the State Environmental Policy Act.

On April 24, 1981, the proposed additions and betterments was submitted to the Utilities Technical Review Committee for review as required by KCC Chapter 13.24. On May 13, 1981, the Committee recommended its approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:


