ORDINANCE NO. 5587

AN ORDINANCE establishing the date for an election to determine whether Federal Way shall be incorporated as a noncharter code city; to elect officers under the plan of government proposed and declaring an emergency.

PREAMBLE:

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 35A.03 of the Revised Code of Washington, a petition for incorporation as a non-charter code city, signed by qualified voters resident within the limits of the proposed city equal in number to ten percent of the votes cast in the proposed area at the last preceding general state election has been presented to the Records & Elections Division.

The petition for incorporation states: that the form of government under which the proposed city will operate in the event it is incorporated shall be Council-Manager, sets forth the proposed boundaries of the proposed corporation, states that the name shall be Federal Way and that the number of inhabitants therein as nearly as may be, is 59,300 and prays that it may be incorporated.

The Superintendent of Elections has determined that the petition for incorporation does not violate the prohibitions contained in RCW 35A.03.101 with regard to number of inhabitants and that there are a sufficient number of valid signatures on the petition.

Pursuant to the provisions of RCW 36.93.100 the Boundary Review Board invoked jurisdiction and in accordance with RCW 36.93.160 on July 23, 1981, filed its written decision approving the proposed incorporation as modified.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Boundary Review Board has deemed this matter approved as modified as of July 23, 1981.

SECTION 2. The name of the proposed city shall be Federal Way.

SECTION 3. The official population of the proposed City of Federal Way, if incorporated, shall be 57,434.

SECTION 4. A special election shall be held on the 15th day of September, 1981, within the area of the proposed City of Federal Way, as hereinafter described, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors the determination of whether it shall be incorporated as a noncharter code city, and to elect officers under the Council-Manager plan of government proposed in the petition.

1            SECTION 5. The boundaries of the proposed City of Federal  
2 Way as modified by the Boundary Review Board are hereby described  
3 as follows:

4            All or portions of the following sections: In Township 22  
5 N., Range 4 E., W.M., Sections 28, 29, 32, 33 and 34. In Township  
6 21 N., Range 4 E., W.M., Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11,  
7 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33  
8 and 34. In Township 21 N., Range 3 E., W.M., Sections 1, 10, 11,  
9 12, 13, 14, 15, 23, 24 and 25; and including a portion of East  
10 Passage of Puget Sound.

11            Beginning at the point of intersection of the East right of  
12 way margin of Pacific Highway S. and the southwest line of  
13 Government Lot 2, Sec. 31, Twp. 21 N., R. 4 E., W.M., said point  
14 being on the common boundary line of King County and Pierce  
15 County; thence Northwesterly along the County line to the point of  
16 intersection with the center of East Passage on Puget Sound (also  
17 known as Admiralty Inlet) as defined by RCW 36.04.170; thence  
18 Northeasterly along the center of East Passage to a point of  
19 intersection with the Westerly extension of the North line of the  
20 South 30 feet of Section 29, Twp. 22 N., R. 4 E., W.M., thence  
21 Easterly along said extended line and continue Easterly along the  
22 North right of way margin of S. 272nd Street to its intersection  
23 with a line 30 feet Northerly of and concentric with the  
24 centerline of S. Star Lake Road; thence Southeasterly along said  
25 concentric line and continue Southeasterly and Easterly along the  
26 Northeasterly and Northerly right of way margin of said S. Star  
27 Lake Road to the Southern most corner of Mark Twain Estates as  
28 recorded in Vol. 89 of Plats, page 62, records of King County,  
29 Washington; thence Easterly to the Southern most corner of Lot 12  
30 Star Lake Villa as recorded in Vol. 86 of Plats, page 3, records  
31 of King County, Washington; thence continuing Easterly along the  
32 North right of way margin of S. Star Lake Road to the East line of  
33 Section 34, Twp. 22 N., R. 4 E., W.M., thence South along said

1 East line to the Southeast corner of said Section 34; thence East  
2 30 feet to the Northerly extension of the East right of way margin  
3 of 51st Avenue S.; thence Southerly along said extension and the  
4 East right of way margin of 51st Avenue S. to the Easterly  
5 extension of the South right of way margin of S. 318th St.; thence  
6 Westerly along said extension and the South right of way margin of  
7 S. 318 St. to the Easterly right of way margin of 44th Ave. S.;  
8 thence Southeasterly along the Northeasterly right of way margin  
9 of 44th Ave. S. and continuing Southerly and Southeasterly along  
10 the Easterly right of way margin of 46th Place S. to the East line  
11 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 15, Twp. 21 N., R. 4 E., W.M.; thence South  
12 along said East line to a line lying 58 feet Southeasterly of and  
13 parallel with the limited Access Line of SR 18; thence  
14 Southwesterly along said parallel line to the Easterly right of  
15 way margin of Peasley Canyon Way S.; thence Southerly along said  
16 East margin to its intersection with the East right of way margin  
17 of Military Road S.; thence continuing Southerly along said East  
18 margin of Military Road S. to its intersection with the Easterly  
19 right of way margin of Edgewood Road; thence Southerly along said  
20 Easterly margin to the South line of Section 33, Twp. 21 N., R. 4  
21 E., W.M., thence West along said South line to the Westerly right  
22 of way margin of Kit Corner Road S.; thence Northwesterly along  
23 the Westerly right of way margin of said Kit Corner Road S. to the  
24 East-West centerline of said Section 33; thence West along the  
25 East-West centerline of Sec. 33 and Sec. 32, said Township and  
26 Range to the West 1/4 corner of said Sec. 32; thence South 24.82  
27 feet to the North line of Gethsemane Cemetery 2 as recorded in  
28 Vol. 93 of Plats pages 98, 99, and 100, records of King County,  
29 Washington; thence West along the North line of said Plat to West  
30 line thereof, said West line being also

1 the East right of way margin of Pacific Highway S.; thence  
2 Southerly along said East margin to the King County, Pierce County  
3 line and the point of beginning.

4 SECTION 6. The election shall be conducted pursuant to RCW  
5 35A.03.085, RCW 35A.03.090, RCW 35A.03.100, RCW 35A.03.110 and  
6 RCW 35A.03.120.


7 SECTION 7. The County Council finds as a fact and declares

9 the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or  
10 for the support of county government and its existing public  
11 institutions.


