

ORDINANCE NO. 5589

2 AN ORDINANCE relating to the County's housing
3 rehabilitation programs; establishing the
4 housing authority as the implementing agency;
5 and amending Ordinance 3269, Section 406,
6 Ordinance 5021, Section 17 and K.C.C. 24.16.060,
7 and 24.24.050.

8 SECTION 1. Ordinance 3269, Section 406, and K.C.C.
9 24.16.060 are amended as follows:

10 Administration. The block grant housing repair program
11 shall be administered by (~~the Department and/or~~) the housing
12 authority, pursuant to an agreement between the housing authority
13 and the county. The director shall undertake periodic sampling
14 of dwellings to insure that the dwellings warrant the program's
15 investment and that the completed repairs are satisfactory.

16 SECTION 2. Ordinance 5021, Section 17, and K.C.C. 24.24.050
17 are hereby amended as follows:

18 Performance of work - Prior approval of homeowner's costs
19 required. Needed repairs to dwellings under the grant and loan
20 assistance programs authorized by this chapter may be performed
21 either by (~~King County~~) the housing authority, acting under
22 an agreement with the county; or by the homeowner, either
23 personally or by contract. The homeowner's material and hired
24 labor costs shall be approved in advance by the (~~county~~)
25 housing authority; provided, that a homeowner shall not be


1 reimbursed for his or her own labor, that of immediate family
2 members, or that of residents of the dwelling.

3 SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect on January 1,
4 1982.
