ORDINANCE NO. 5601

AN ORDINANCE repealing Ordinance No. 5542, and concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to approve subject to conditions(modified) the application for TIMBERLAND DESIGNATION, petitioned by KENNETH H. AND MARY EASTLACK, and designated Building and Land Development Division File No. 203-80-S.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5542 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance does hereby adopt and incorporate herein the findings and conclusions contained in the corrected report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner dated July 3, 1981, filed with the Clerk of the Council on July 23, 1981, recommending action upon the application of KENNETH H. AND MARY EASTLACK, for TIMBERLAND DESIGNATION, described in Building and Land Development File No. 203-80-S.


SECTION 3. The recommendation by the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to approve subject to conditions (modified), is hereby adopted by the Council of King County. Those conditions, if any which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within six months of Council approval, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the Building and Land Development Division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to
