ORDINANCE NO. 5619

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as "32nd Avenue South/South 298th Street" to Lakehaven Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as "32nd Avenue South/South 298th Street" to Lakehaven Sewer District was filed with the County Council July 17, 1981.

2. Lakehaven Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 81-848 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Lakehaven Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated May 28, 1981, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 17th day of August, 19 81, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Lakehaven Sewer District of the area known as "32nd Avenue South/South 298th Street" and described in Section 3 herein is approved. King County Council Annexation Report on "32nd Avenue South/South 298th Street" is attached and made a part of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.

SECTION 3. The area known as "32nd Avenue South/South 298th Street" to be annexed is described as follows:


1 The Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of the
