ORDINANCE NO. **5781**

AN ORDINANCE relating to cost-of-living adjustments and amending Ordinance 5757, Sections 2 and 36.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 5757, Section 2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Within fund appropriations are sums to cover merit pay and labor settlements. The County Executive is authorized to distribute the required portion of these funds among the affected positions in each operating fund effective January 1, 1982. In the event cost-of-living adjustments are greater than funding provided, all budgets shall be augmented as required from funds available to the County not otherwise appropriated; provided that an ordinance shall be forwarded to the Council appropriating such funds by division. ~~((No cost-of-living adjustment for employee whose salary is \$30,000 or more per annum shall exceed 6% of base salary.))~~ The amount and distribution of cost-of-living adjustments for all employees not covered by collective bargaining agreements shall be as provided by a salary ordinance, adopted by the Council.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 5757, Section 36 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SPECIAL PROGRAMS - From the Current Expense Fund there shall be hereby appropriated to:

Provided that:

A. The Executive Contingency contains an amount of \$400,000 which is hereby designated as an emergency fund for human services (such as those within the Dept. of Youth and the Division of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse and the Dept. of Human Services). It is the intent of the Council that these funds be used as a one-time appropriation to facilitate the transition to program reductions which may be necessitated

1 action of the State Legislature. Allocation of such funds shall
2 be subject to approval by the Council through specific program
3 appropriations.

4 B. The Executive present the total costs and benefits of
5 developing a new Management Information System for the new
6 corrections facility to the Council for review and approval by
7 motion prior to expenditure of budgeted funds. If approved, the
8 Executive present quarterly reports on the progress of the
9 development of the Jail MIS system including changes in the
10 project's scope, schedule, costs, and benefits.

11 C. The Executive contingency contains an amount of up to
12 \$115,000 for Agriculture Programs. Allocation of such funds
13 shall be subject to appeal by the Council through specific
14 program appropriations.
