

ORDINANCE NO. 5790

AN ORDINANCE relating to establishment of S.E. 63rd Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation has made an examination of S.E. 63rd Street along the course and description set forth below and has made a favorable report upon the same, as required by R.C.W. 36.81.050.

SECTION 2: Said road shall be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of S.E. 63rd Street, said point being N. 73°12'00"E a distance of 1241.34 ft. from the S.W. corner of Sec. 23, Twp. 24N. R.5E., W.M.; thence in an easterly direction a distance of 2455.39 ft. to a terminus on the centerline of Lakemont Blvd. S.E. at the intersection of S.E. Cougar Mountain Road, said terminus being N. 76°06'05"W. a distance of 1948.55 ft. from the S.E. corner of said Sec. 23.

2455.39 ft. = 0.465 miles


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1 SECTION 3: King County Council finds that the establishment

3 public necessity.




