

ORDINANCE NO. 5849

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$189,141 to Airport Homes Income for Manufactured Housing Subdivision; transferring \$10,000 from the cancellation of Condominium Purchase Legal Assistance to Family Housing Opportunities Program; cancelling \$766,897 from Airport Homes Relocation and 1981 Bonus Block Grant; appropriating \$54,573 to Land Writedown; and amending Ordinance No. 5757, Section 57, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$189,141 to Airport Homes Income, CDI-705, for use in Manufactured Housing Subdivision, CDF-705, from program income.

SECTION 2. There is hereby approved a transfer of \$10,000 from the cancellation of Condominium Purchase Legal Assistance, CDC-705, to the Family Housing Opportunities Program, CDA-705, for use in the Manufactured Housing Subdivision, CDF-705.

SECTION 3. There is hereby approved a total cancellation of \$766,897 from Airport Homes Relocation, CDD-705, in the amount of \$746,750 and from the 1981 Bonus Block Grant in the amount of \$20,147 due to a reduction in the HUD Grant.

SECTION 4. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$54,573 to Land Writedown, CDH-705, to carry out the intent of the 1976 Bonus Block Grant from program income.

SECTION 5. Ordinance No. 5757, Section 57, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:
