

ORDINANCE NO. 5857

AN ORDINANCE repealing Ordinance No. 5766, and concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying certain property upon the application of HIGHLINE PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT #401, designated Building and Land Development File No. 258-81-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5766 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the October 28, 1981 report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, filed with the Clerk of the Council on November 16, 1981, on the application of HIGHLINE PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT #401 to reclassify certain property described in Building and Land Development File No. 258-81-R.

SECTION 3. The recommendation by the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to reclassify the subject property from RS 7200 and RS 7200 (Potential RM 900) to RM 900, subject to conditions, is hereby adopted by the Council of King County. Those conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied on or before October 28, 1982, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. (If none, the effective date shall be ten days after enactment.) Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the Building and Land Development Division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
