

ORDINANCE NO. 5887

AN ORDINANCE reestablishing and continuing the Office of Agriculture; appropriating \$98,676 to the Office of Agriculture from the Executive Contingency in the Current Expense Fund; amending Ordinance No. 5757, Sections 36 and 73, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. As reestablished the Office of Agriculture shall continue to be responsible for implementation of the King County Agricultural Protection Program and planning and operation of County agricultural support programs.

SECTION 2. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$98,676 to the Office of Agriculture from Executive Contingency in the Current Expense Fund to be used for agricultural programs.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 5757, Section 73, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Office of Agriculture (~~(\$14,727)~~) \$113,403

SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 5757, Section 36, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Special Programs (~~(\$9,460,335)~~) \$9,361,659

Included in Special Programs is an Executive Contingency of (~~(\$885,273)~~) \$786,597 which shall not be expended unless the County Executive certifies in writing that funds are available and requests the County Council adopt an additional appropriation ordinance; upon adoption such funds may be expended for the purpose specified.
