

ORDINANCE NO. 5908

AN ORDINANCE concurring with the Recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying certain property upon the application of ROY KUROSU, designated Building and Land Development File No. 266-81-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the February 17, 1982 report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, filed with the Clerk of the Council on March 4, 1982, on the application of ROY KUROSU to reclassify certain property described in Building and Land Development File No. 266-81-R.

SECTION 2. The recommendation by the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to reclassify the subject property from RS 7200 (potential RM 1800) to RM 1800-P subject to conditions \_\_\_\_\_ is hereby adopted by the Council of King County. Those conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied on or before Decemeber 31, 1982, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the Building and Land Development Divisiion shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
