Exemption. The following exemptions shall apply to the 9 'No Shooting Area" as specified in Ordinance 474 and K.C.C. 12.68.420 with 10 the following conditions: 11 Shooting shall be allowed only on the property commonly known as 12 "Riley's Aqua Barn Ranch". 13 B. The type of shooting to be allowed shall be muzzleloading, black 14 powder type rifles and handguns. 15 C. All shooting shall occur only during the following days and hours: 16 1. May 29, 1982 - 9:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. 17 2. May 30, 1982 - 11:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. 18 3. May 31, 1982 - 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 noon. 19 D. All shooting shall be done at least five-hundred feet (500') from 20 he Maple Valley Road (SR 169). 21 E.
