ORDINANCE NO. 5975

AN ORDINANCE relating to stock restricted areas; repealing Ordinance 133, Sections 1 through 3 and King County Code 11.24.010.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. All of King County, except national forest lands owned by the Federal Government, is designated a stock restricted area in which it shall be unlawful to permit livestock, as defined in K.C.C. 21.04.390, to run at large.

SECTION 2. Should any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. Any violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor and the punishment shall be provided by the laws of the State of Washington.

SECTION 4. King County Ordinance No. 133, Sections 1 through 3 and K.C.C. 11.24.010 are each repealed.
