

ORDINANCE NO. **6004**

AN ORDINANCE relating to the justice court of King County; stating the number of justices to be elected in each justice court district; providing for the location of a central office, courtroom and records of each court; authorizing justice court commissioners when necessary; providing for departments into which each justice court shall be initially organized; providing for the name of each justice court district; providing for the allocation of time and salary of each justice who serves part-time as a municipal judge; setting the boundaries of each justice court district; amending Ordinance 3714, Sections 1 through 13; amending KCC 2.68.050; 070; 090; 110; 130; 150; 170; 190; 210; 230; 250; 280; repealing Ordinance 3743, Section 2 and KCC 2.68.270.

PREAMBLE:

This ordinance contains provisions requiring that it not take effect until January 10, 1983; the present effective date by which all elected judges of the district court will have served their elected term of office, under the provisions of RCW 3.34. It is understood that activities of the court may require amendments to the present district court plan, Ordinance No. 3714, prior to this ordinance having legal effect. In those cases where amendments are necessary, it is the intent of the Council that such amendments shall be prepared to amend the present district court plan and this ordinance, the future district court plan, scheduled to be effective January 10, 1983.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 3743, Section 2, and KCC 2.68.270 are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 3714, Section 2, and KCC 2.68.050 are hereby amended as follows:

Name of the Court: The Justice Court of the State of Washington in and for Airport District, County of King, organized as follows:

1. Name of the justice court district: Airport District.
2. Population: ((56,800)) 59,800.
3. Number of justices to be elected: One full-time justice.

1 4. Location of central office, courtroom and records:
2 Within the vicinity of Burien.

3 5. Location of other courtroom: None (except as provided
4 by other cities for hearing violations of municipal ordinances).

18 Washington in and for Aukeen District, County of King, organized
19 as follows:

20 1. Name of the justice court district: Aukeen District.

21 2. Population: ((94,000)) 137,000.

22 3. Number of justices to be elected: ((Two)) Three full-time
23 justices.

24 4. Location of central office, courtroom and records:
25 Within the City of Auburn.

26 5. Location of other courtrooms: Within the Cities of Kent
27 and Enumclaw and no other (except as provided by other cities for
28 hearing violations of municipal ordinances).

29 6. Number and location of justice court commissioners to be
30 authorized: One justice court commissioner at the central
31 office, and one each at Kent and Enumclaw, together with such

3 7. The departments into which the justice court shall be
4 organized initially, including municipal departments: Cities of
5 Auburn and Kent.

6 8. The allocation of time and salary, if any, of any
7 justice who shall serve part-time in the municipal department:
8 None, pending future amendment of the plan.

9 SECTION 4. Ordinance 3714, Section 4 and KCC 2.68.090 are
10 hereby amended as follows:

11 1. Name of the justice court district: Bellevue District.

12 2. Population: ((87,400)) 108,100.

13 3. Number of justices to be elected: Two full-time
14 justices.

15 4. Location of central office, courtroom and records:
16 Within the vicinity of Bellevue, pending future amendment of the
17 plan.

18 5. Location of other courtrooms: None (except as provided
19 by other cities for hearing violations of municipal ordinances).

20 6. Number and location of justice court commissioners to be
21 authorized: One justice court commissioner at the central
22 office, together with such additional court commissioners as the
23 district justice may require.

24 7. The departments into which the justice court shall be
25 organized initially, including municipal departments: Cities of
26 Bellevue, Clyde Hill, Hunts Point, Medina and Yarrow Point.

27 8. The allocation of time and salary, if any, of any
28 justice who shall serve part-time in the municipal department:
29 None, pending future amendment of the plan.

30 SECTION 5. Ordinance 3714, Section 5, and KCC 2.68.110
31 are hereby amended as follows:

1 Name of the Court: The Justice Court of the State of
 2 Washington in and for Federal Way District, County of King,
 3 organized as follows:

4 1. Name of the justice court district: Federal Way
 5 district.

6 2. Population: ((58,000)) 76,800.

7 3. Number of justices to be elected: two full-
 8 time justices.

9 4. Location of central office, courtroom and records: In
 10 the vicinity of Federal Way.

11 5. Location of other courtrooms: None (except as provided
 12 by other cities for hearing violations of municipal ordinances).

13 6. Number and location of justice court commissioners to be
 14 authorized: One justice court commissioner at the central office,
 15 together with such additional court commissioners as the district
 16 justice may require.

17 7. The departments into which the justice court shall be
 18 organized initially, including municipal departments: None,
 19 pending future amendment of the plan.

20 8. The allocation of time and salary, if any, of any
 21 justice who shall serve part-time in the municipal department:
 22 None, pending future amendment of the plan.

23 SECTION 6. Ordinance 3714, Section 6, and KCC 2.68.130 are
 24 hereby amended as follows:

25 Name of the Court: The Justice Court of the State of
 26 Washington in and for Issaquah District, County of King, organized
 27 as follows:

28 1. Name of the justice court district: Issaquah District.

29 2. Population: ((25,000)) 35,100.

30 3. Number of justices to be elected: One ((part)) full
 31 time justice.

6. Number and location of justice court commissioners to be authorized: One justice court commissioner at the central office together with such additional court commissioners as the district justice may require.

7. The departments into which the justice court shall be organized initially, including municipal departments: City of Issaquah.

8. The allocation of time and salary, if any, of any justice who shall serve part-time in the municipal department: None, pending future amendment of the plan.

SECTION 7. Ordinance 3714, Section 7, and KCC 2.68.150 are hereby amended as follows:

Name of the Court: The Justice Court of the State of Washington in and for Mercer Island District, County of King organized as follows:

1. Name of the justice court district: Mercer Island District.

2. Population: ((~~21,000~~)) 22,700

3. Number of justices to be created: One part-time justice.

4. Location of central office, courtroom and records:
Within the boundaries of the City of Mercer Island.

24 the vicinity of 175th and 185 Streets on Midvale Road, Linden
25 Avenue or the old brick Firlands Road.

26 5. Location of other courtrooms: None (except as provided
27 by other cities for hearing violations of municipal ordinances).

28 6. Number and location of justice court commissioners to
29 be authorized: One justice court commissioner at the central
30 office, together with such additional court commissioners as the
31 district justice may require.

1 7. The departments into which the justice court shall be
2 organized initially, including municipal departments: None,
3 pending future amendment of the plan.

4 8. The allocation of time and salary, if any, of any
5 justice who shall serve part-time in the municipal department:

18 the vicinity of the Vashon business center.

19 5. Location of other courtrooms: None (except as provided
20 by other cities for hearing violations of municipal ordinances).
