ORDINANCE NO. 6013

AN ORDINANCE approving Propst Estate Engineering Report as a Water Comprehensive Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On March 22, 1982, Propst Estate adopted an Article of Resolution approving the Estate's Engineering Report as its water comprehensive plan.

On April 19, 1982, King County Building and Land Development issued a Final Declaration of Non-Significance on adoption of the Estate's Engineering Report as its water comprehensive plan.

On March 24, 1982, the Engineering Report was submitted to the Utilities Technical Review Committee for review, as required by KCC Chapter 13.24. On April 24, 1982, the Committee recommended its approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Propst Estate Engineering Report, as adopted by an Article of Resolution (attached) as the Estate's Water Comprehensive Plan, is hereby approved.
