ORDINANCE NO. 6036

AN ORDINANCE approving Phase I Additions and Betterments to Water District No. 104 Comprehensive Sewer Plan (Resolutions No. 1326 and No. 1327).

PREAMBLE:

On March 15, 1982, Water District No. 104 adopted Resolution No. 1327 which provided for Phase I Additions and Betterments to the district's comprehensive sewer plan.

On March 15, 1982, Water District No. 104 adopted Resolution No. 1326 concurring in the Declaration of Non-Significance on adoption of Phase I additions and betterments to the district's comprehensive sewer plan.

On April 13, 1982, the plan for Phase I additions and betterments was submitted to the Utilities Technical Review Committee for review, as required by KCC Chapter 13.24. On April 28, 1982, the Committee recommended its approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Phase I Additions and Betterments to the Water District No. 104 Comprehensive Sewer Plan, as adopted by district Resolution No. 1326 (attached) is hereby approved.
