

ORDINANCE NO. 6054

AN ORDINANCE concurring with the Recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying certain property upon the application of LIBERTY VIEW designated Building and Land Development File No. 265-81-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the June 11, 1982 report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, filed with the Clerk of the Council on June 28, 1982, on the application of LIBERTY VIEW to reclassify certain property described in Building and Land Development File No. 265-81-R.

SECTION 2. The recommendation by the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to reclassify the subject property from SR (7200), (9600) and (15,000) to RS 7200 and RS 9600, except for the easterly 150 feet of the site which should be rezoned to RS 15,000 in lieu of RS 9600 is hereby adopted by the Council of King County. Those conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within one year of Council approval or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. (If none, the effective date shall be ten days after enactment.) Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the Building and Land Development Division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
