

ORDINANCE NO. 6085

AN ORDINANCE approving the City of Bothell Comprehensive Sewer and Water Plan (November, 1980).

PREAMBLE:

Finding that the City of Bothell Sewer and Water Comprehensive Plan overlaps and duplicates the plans of neighboring sewer and water special districts, the Council has relied upon the following general principles in its review and approval:

- A. The Council generally should discourage abnormally irregular boundaries;
- B. The Council should encourage the creation and preservation of logical service areas, giving particular notice to topography, drainage basins, and physical boundaries;
- C. The Council, in its review of sewer and water comprehensive plans, generally should acknowledge previously approved plans, giving particular notice to existing service delivery systems.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The City of Bothell Comprehensive Water and Sewer Plan is hereby approved, except as set forth in Sections 2 and 3 of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. Those portions of the approved Bothell Water Comprehensive Plan which extend beyond the corporate boundaries of the City of Bothell shall be limited as set forth in Attachment A of this ordinance, which shall be a part of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. Those portions of the approved Bothell Sewer Comprehensive Plan which extend beyond the corporate boundaries

1 of the City of Bothell shall be limited as set forth in Attachment  
2 B of this ordinance, which shall be a part of this ordinance.

3 SECTION 4. By this Comprehensive Plan approval, it is  
4 acknowledged that the boundaries identified in Attachments A and  
5 B are generalized boundaries for planning purposes only, and that  
6 the placement of individual service connections may require further  
7 negotiation between the City and neighboring special purpose  
8 governments.

9 SECTION 5. Approval of this Comprehensive Plan does not  
10 imply authorization of an exclusive franchise to serve the North  
11 Creek Valley. The County Council will consider a Water District  
12 No. 104 service extension, annexation and/or comprehensive plan  
13 amendment to serve the same area or portions thereof.

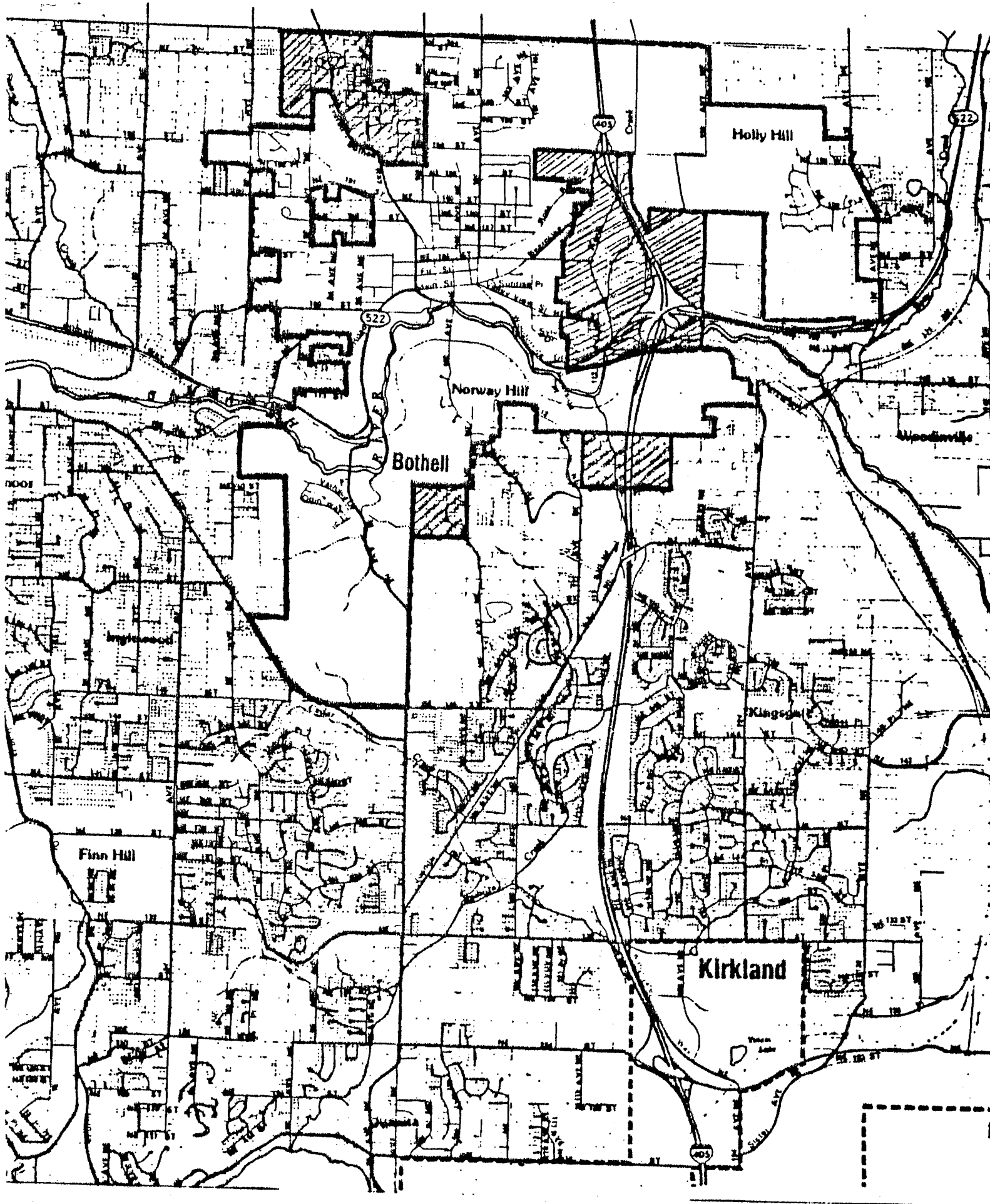

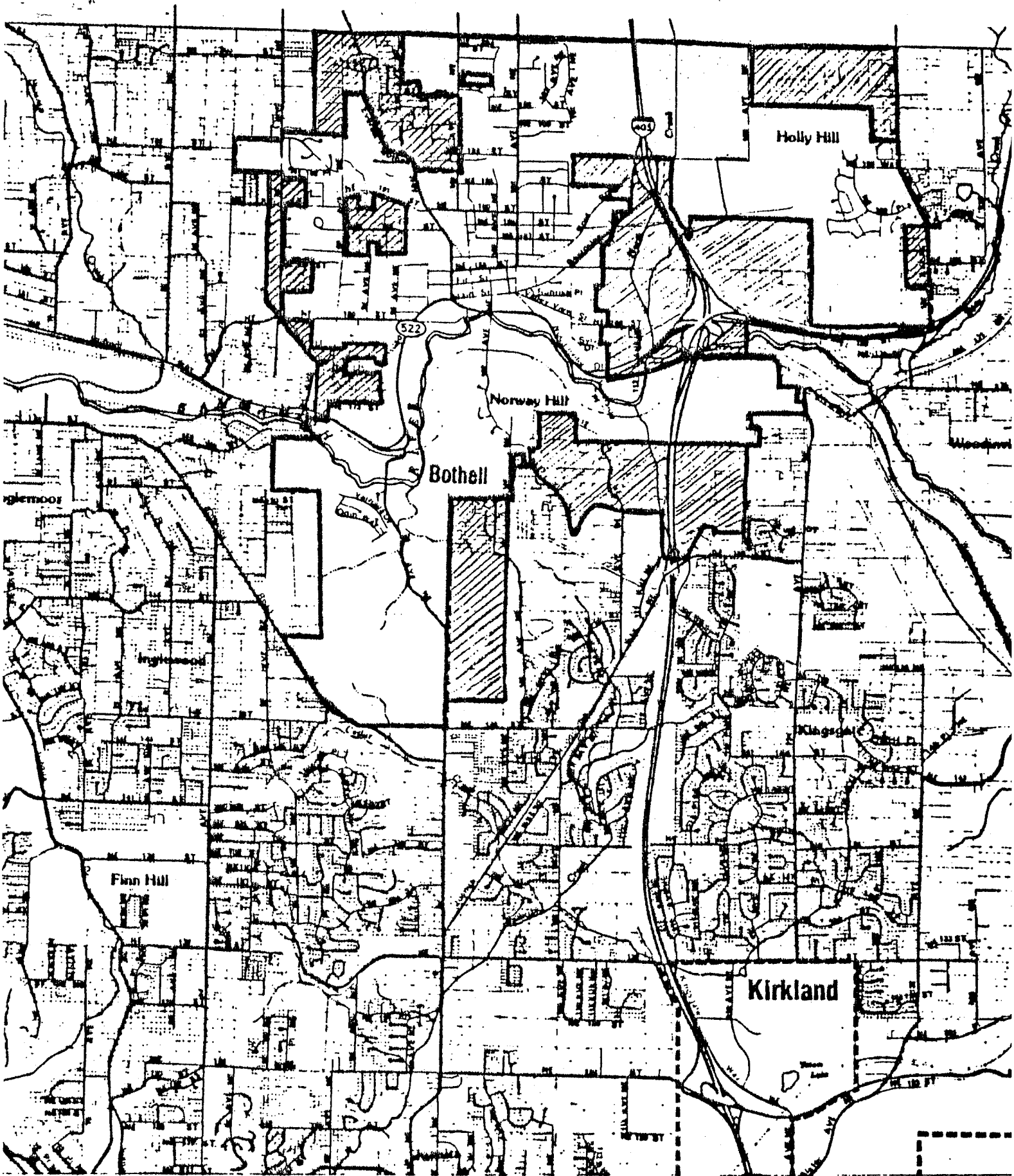
