ORDINANCE NO. 6088

AN ORDINANCE approving Amendment No. 1 to the Union Hill Water Association Comprehensive Water Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On June 1, 1982, Union Hill Water Association adopted Resolution No. 1 which amends the Association's Comprehensive Water Plan to provide for the construction of a 850,000 gallon water storage tank.

On June 25, 1982, the Building and Land Development Division filed a Declaration of Non-Significance for the Union Hill Water Association Comprehensive Water Plan Amendment No. 1.

On June 9, 1982, the proposed comprehensive water plan amendment was submitted to the UTRC for review as required by KCC Chapter 13.24. The Committee has recommended its approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Comprehensive Plan Amendment No. 1 to the Union Hill Water Association Water Comprehensive Plan, as adopted by Association Resolution No. 1 (attached) is hereby approved.
