## ORDINANCE NO. 6128

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

appropriation of \$72,000 to the Department of Youth Services from Executive Contingency to support the 1982 cost of an educational program for the County juvenile detention center. By taking this action, the County is not acknowledging final responsibility for the funding of juvenile detention education. The County agrees to organize and immediately fund this program per the Supreme Court Decision (Tommy P. vs Spokane) during the interim before the responsibility of the state is established.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 5757, Section 36, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Special Programs ((\$2,7561,7237)) \$2,489,237

Included in Special Programs is an Executive Contingency of ((\$108,629)) \$36,629 which shall not be expended unless the County Executive certifies in writing that funds are available and requests the County Council adopt an additional appropriation ordinance, upon adoption, such funds may be expended for the purpose specified.
