Proposed Ordinance No. 82-461

3 ORDINANCE NO. 6152

4 AN ORDINANCE relating to fees for costs of
5 environmental impact statements; deleting the
6 maximum amount to be billed the applicant; and
7 amending Ordinance 3026, Section 16, Ordinance
8 5788, Section 1, and KCC 20.44.150.

7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL:

8 SECTION 1. Ordinance 3026, Section 16, Ordinance 5788,
9 Section 1 and KCC 20.44.150 are each hereby amended to read as
10 follows:

11 Fees. A. The following fees shall be required for applica-
12 tions for county licenses and actions filed by a person or non-
13 county agency in addition to the regular application and
14 inspection fees:

15 1. Actions in categories without environmental signifi-
16 cance: no fee required;

17 2. Actions requiring an individual determination of en-
18 vironmental significance and resulting in declaration of no
19 significant impact; provided, that such fee shall not be
20 required for applications made to the county where this fee has
21 been incorporated into a regular application fee, the fee shall
22 be based on the total floor area of the structure(s) as
23 follows:

24	4,000 to 10,000 square feet.....	\$ 65.00
25	10,001 to 30,000 square feet.....	130.00
26	30,001 to 70,000 square feet.....	195.00
27	70,001 to 100,000 square feet.....	260.00
28	more than 100,000 square feet.....	325.00

29 3. Actions requiring preparation by the county of an
30 environmental impact statement:

1 a. Five hundred dollars to be deposited with the
2 responsible official prior to commencement of preparation of
3 the impact statement by the county, plus

4 b. Actual cost of additional time spent by regular
5 county professional, technical and clerical employees required
6 for the preparation and distribution of the applicant's impact
7 statement; provided that such costs shall be accounted for
8 properly; provided, further, that no costs shall be charged for
9 processing of the application which takes place with or without
10 the requirement for an impact statement and which is covered by
11 the regular application fee, and no costs shall be charged for
12 review of completed impact statements by county officials,

13 c. Additional costs, if any, for experts not employed
14 by the county, texts, printing and for any other actual costs
15 required for the preparation and distribution of the impact
16 statement; provided, that no additional costs can be charged
17 for existing studies or general information already in the
18 possession of the county,

19 ~~((d. Additional costs as described in subsections
20 A(3)(b) and A(3)(c) of this section shall not exceed two
21 thousand dollars, and shall be billed to the applicant in five
22 hundred dollar increments as they are incurred,))~~

23 ~~((e.))~~ d. Any unexpended balance from deposits made by
24 the applicant shall be returned upon completion of the final
25 EIS;

26 4. Actions requiring an environmental impact statement
27 which is prepared by a private applicant:

28 a. Two hundred fifty dollars to be deposited with the
29 responsible official prior to submission of the applicant's
30 proposed draft EIS, plus additional costs as set forth in sub-
31 sections ~~((A(3)(b)))~~ A.3.b. through ~~((A(3)(d)))~~ A.3.c. of this
32 section,

1 b. Any unexpended balance from deposits made by the
2 applicant shall be returned upon completion of the final EIS.

3 B. In the case of those actions requiring environmental
4 impact statements, the responsible official shall, to the maxi-
5 mum extent practicable consistent with the requirements of pro-
6 ducing an adequate environmental impact statement, utilize
7 information, studies and tests and assistance set forth in any
8 proposed draft EIS provided by the applicant in order to mini-
9 mize additional costs for the preparation of the impact
10 statement;

11 C. In the case of those noncounty actions requiring
12 environmental impact statements, the responsible official shall
13 inform the applicant, in writing, of the projected scope, cost
14 and timetable of the EIS prior to accepting the deposit re-
15 quired in subsection ((A(3)(a))) A.3.a. of this section;

16 D. The county adopts by reference WAC 197-10-470, as now
17 or hereafter amended, governing charges to the public for costs
18 of reproduction of environmental documents. Within thirty days
19 of the effective date of the ordinance codified in this
