ORDINANCE NO. 6178

AN ORDINANCE authorizing King County to enter into a multi-year lease for the Women's Program and authorizing the payment thereof.

PREAMBLE:

In accordance with the provisions of K.C.C. 4.04.040 the King County Council may adopt an ordinance permitting the County to enter into contracts requiring the payment of funds from the appropriations of subsequent fiscal years. The Managers of the Smith Tower Building are willing to enter into a 17 month lease agreement for the benefit of the Women's Program at a rental rate which is favorable to the County. It has been determined that it is in the best interests of King County that such a lease be secured.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The County Executive on behalf of the County is hereby authorized to enter into a lease agreement for 631 square feet of office space in the Smith Tower Building. This lease is for a term beginning August 1, 1982, and ending December 31, 1983, at a rental rate of \$9.50 per square foot per year which will include utilities and janitorial/maintenance services.
