

ORDINANCE NO. 6198

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$191,605 to the Public Health Pooling Fund from State and Federal sources for the purpose of making contract adjustments, for making new appropriations, and for correcting an error, in personal health programs and amending Ordinance No. 5757, Section 51, as amended and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$191,605 is hereby appropriated to the Public Health Pooling Fund from State and Federal grant sources for personal health programs.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 5757, Section 51, as amended, is hereby amended as follows:

King County Services	(\$14,237,247)	<u>\$14,187,643</u>

SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of County government and its existing public institutions.
